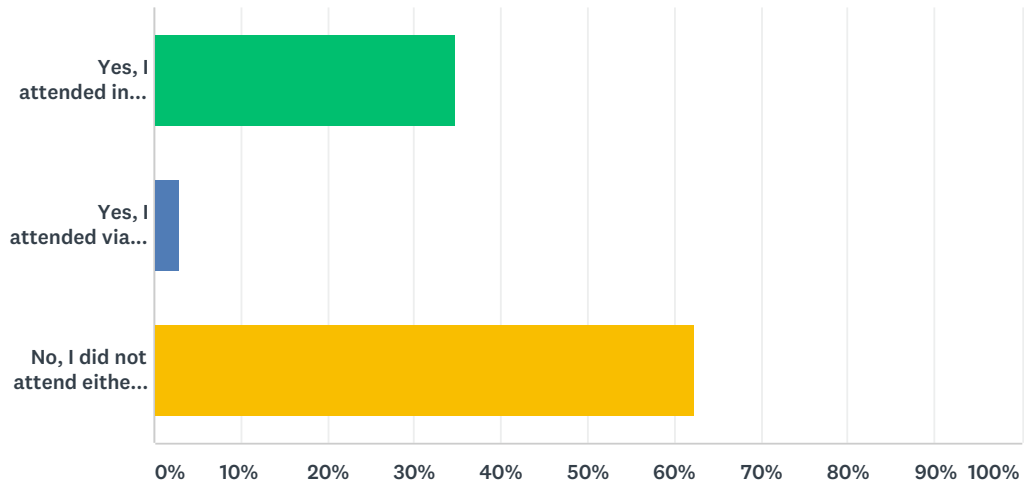


Q1 Did you attend the DNA Town Hall on March 11, 2019?

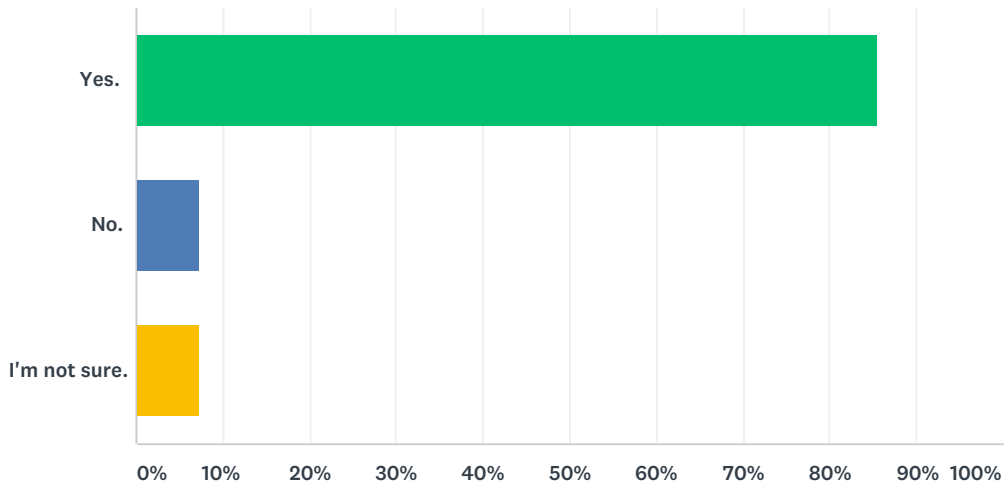

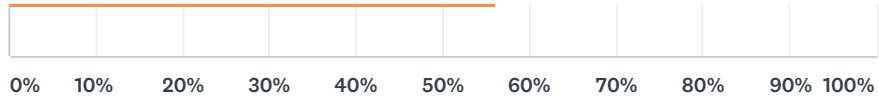

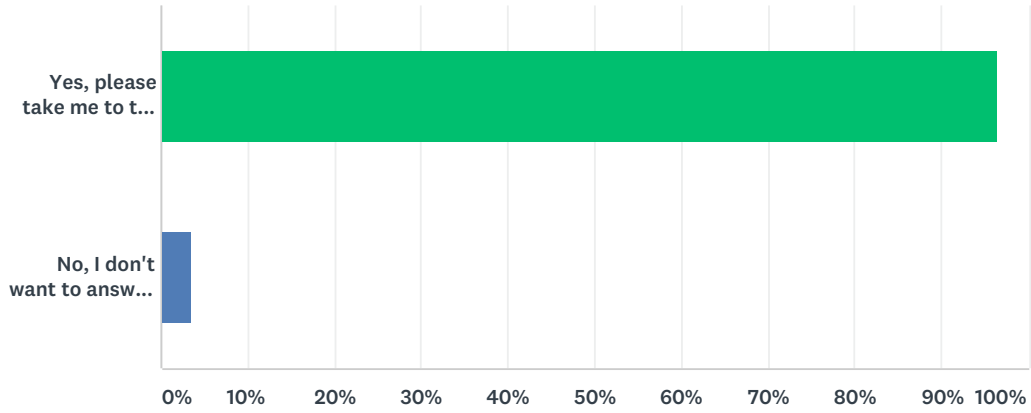

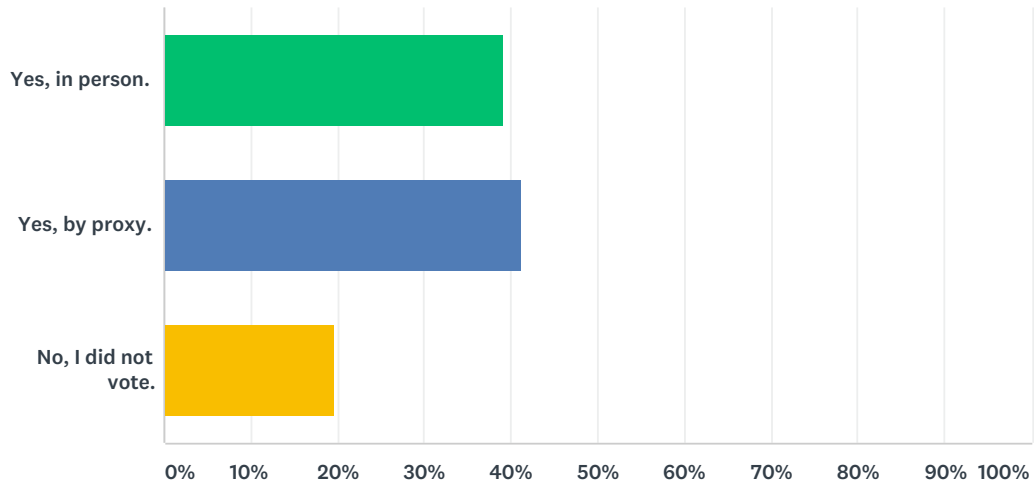

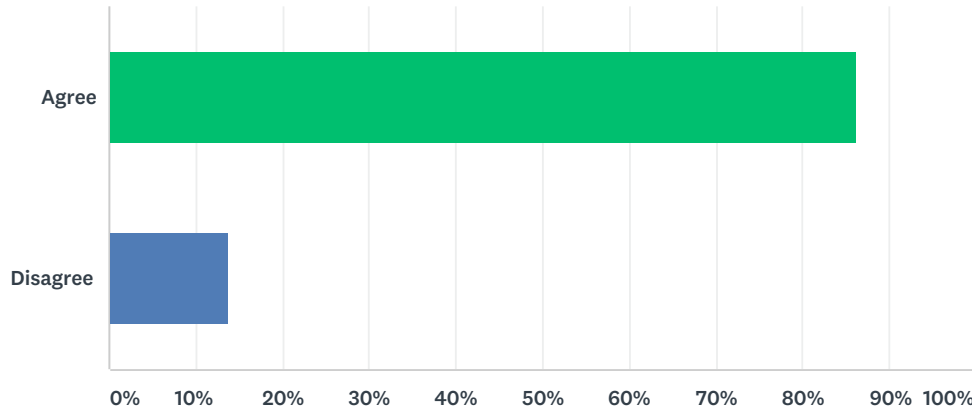

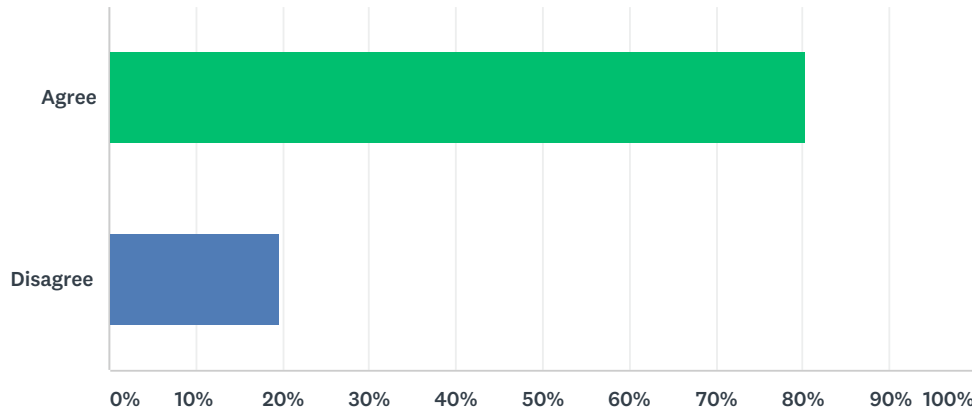

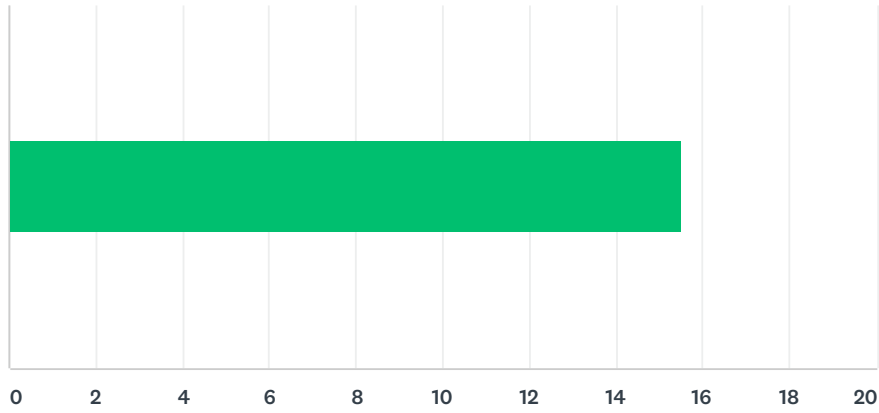

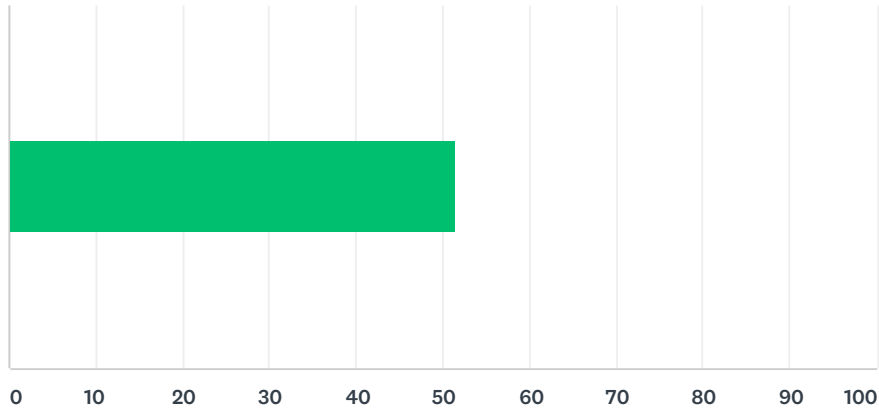

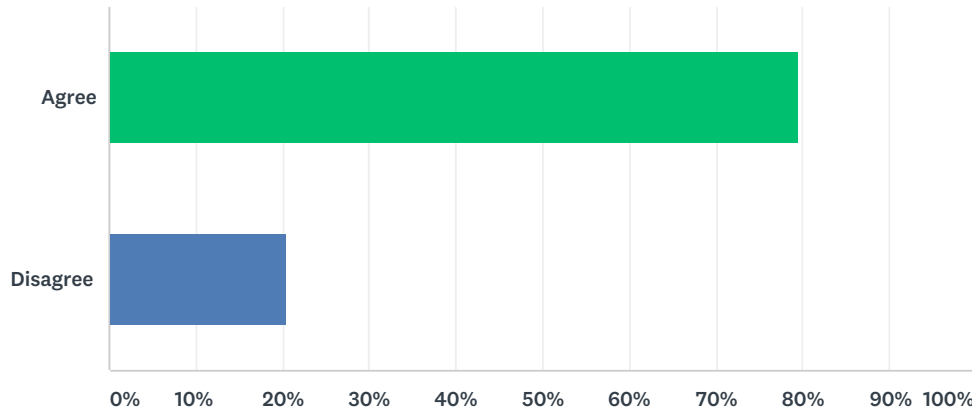

Q10 Voting (Article V, Section 4). This amendment prohibits any proxy voting.

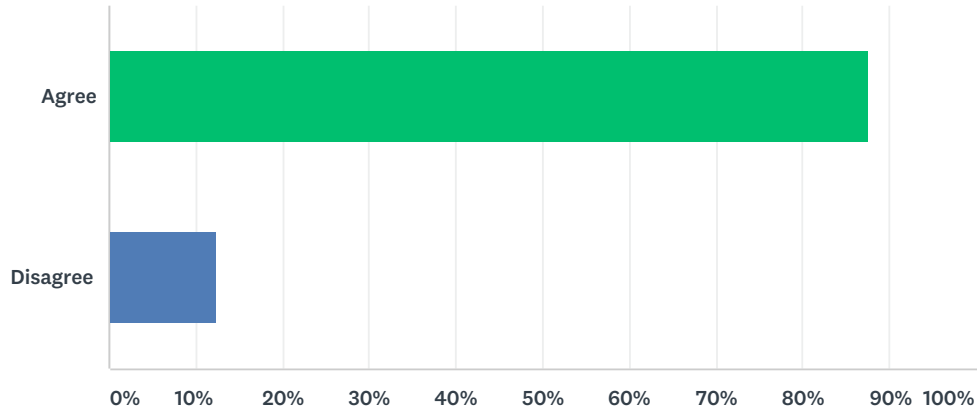

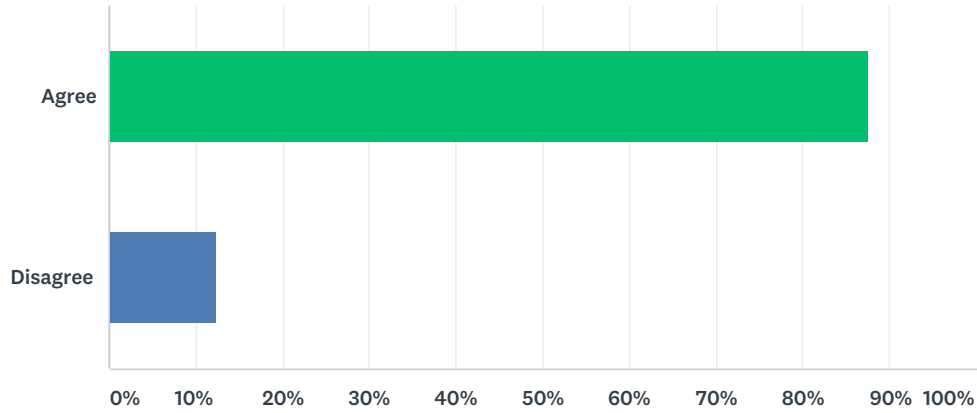

Q14 Quorum (Article VII, Section 5). This amendment changes quorum from being five percent (5%) of the total active membership to ten percent (10%).

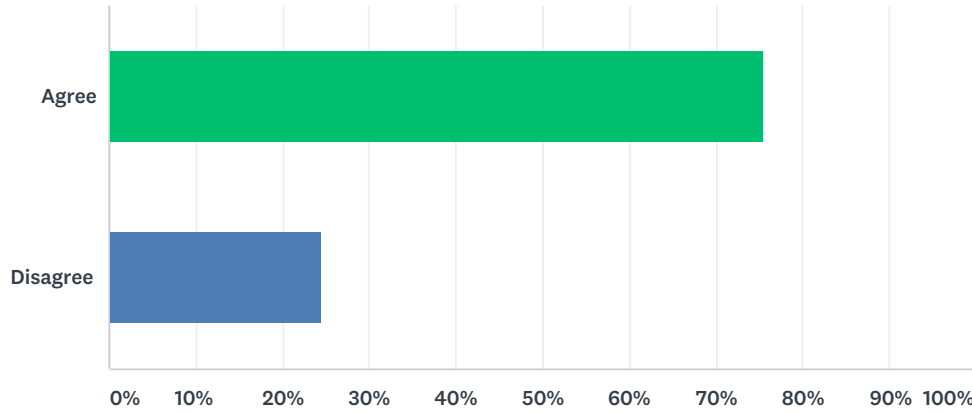

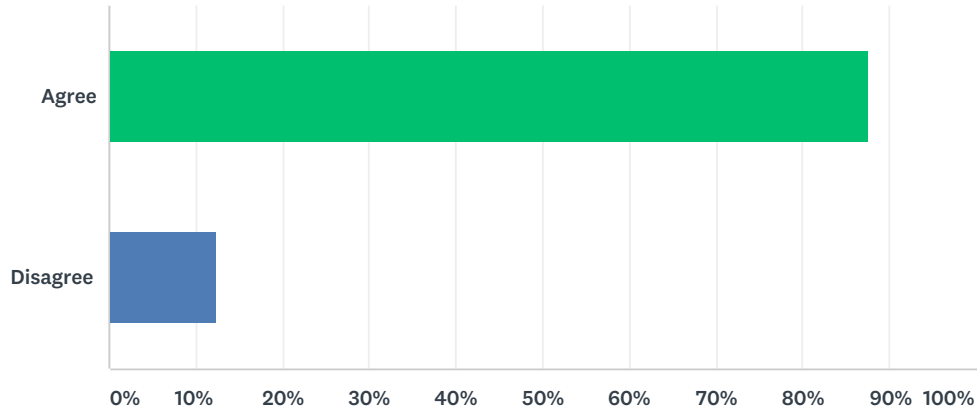

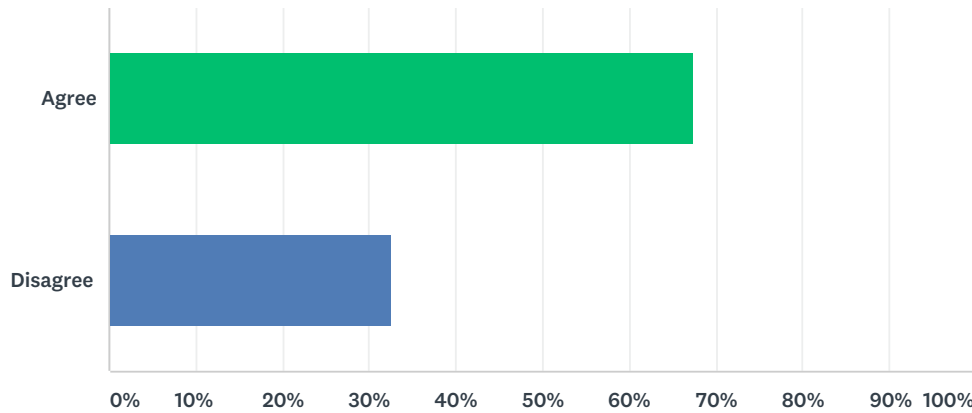

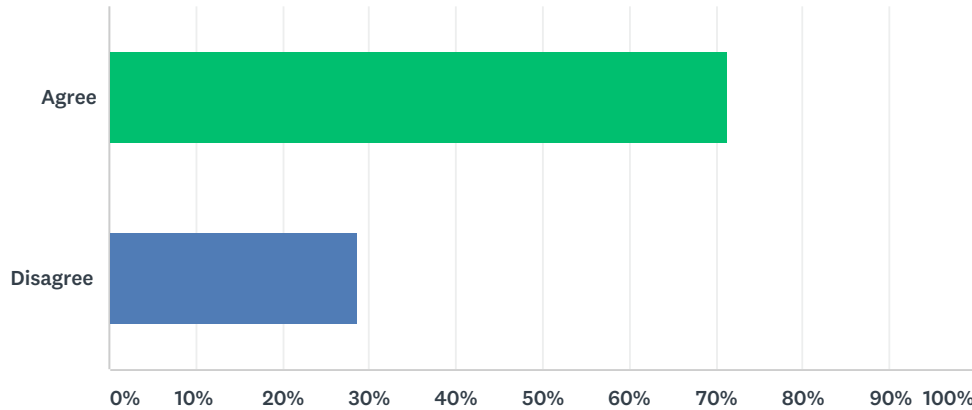

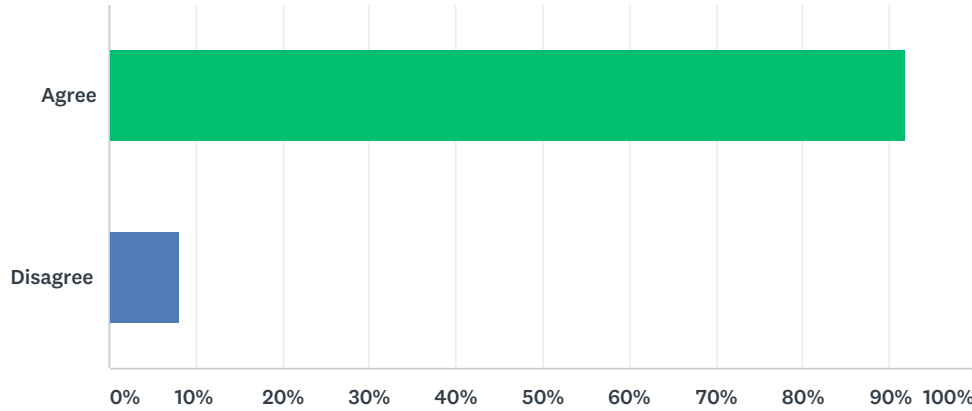

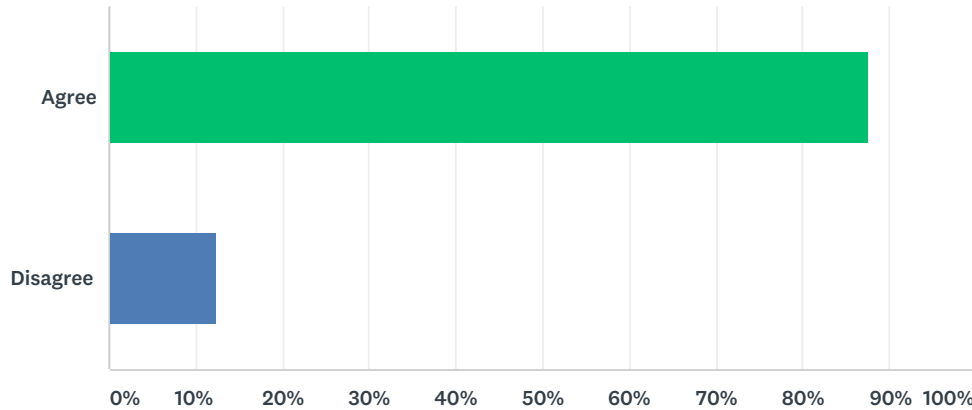

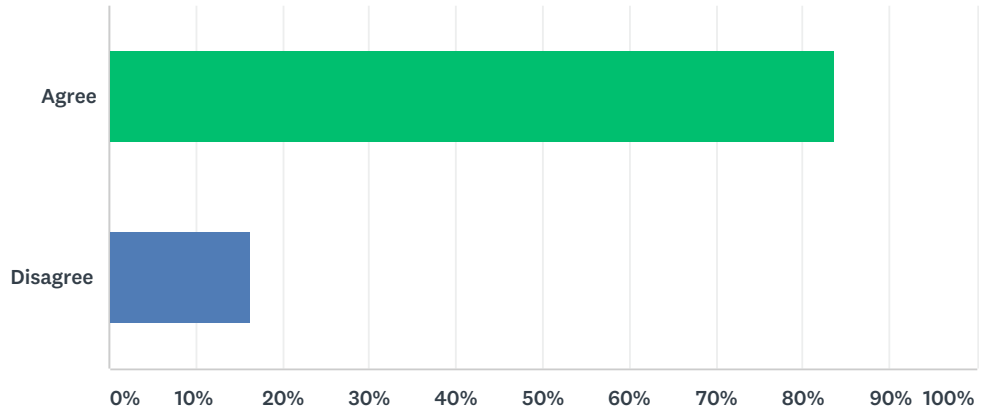

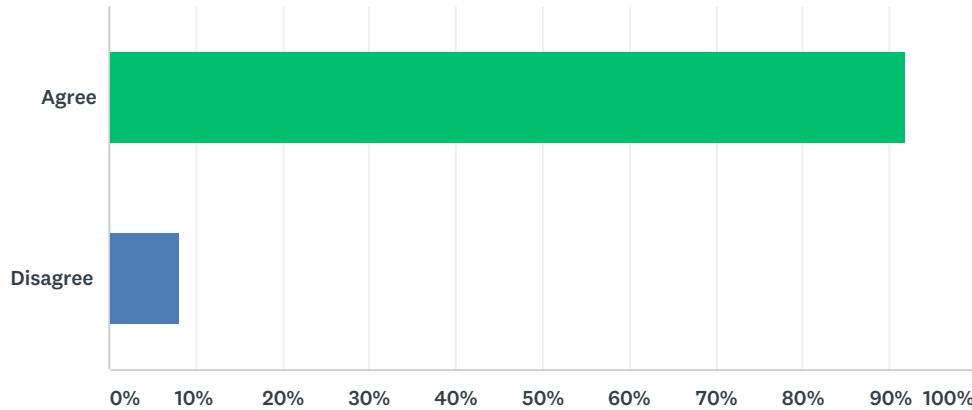

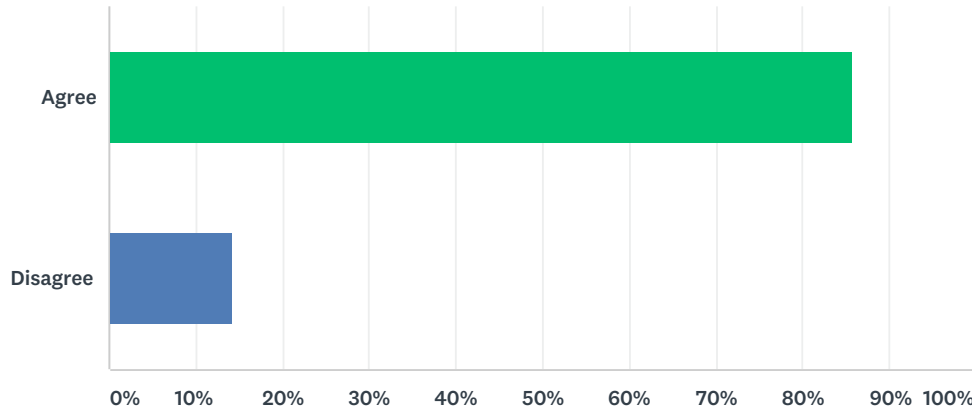

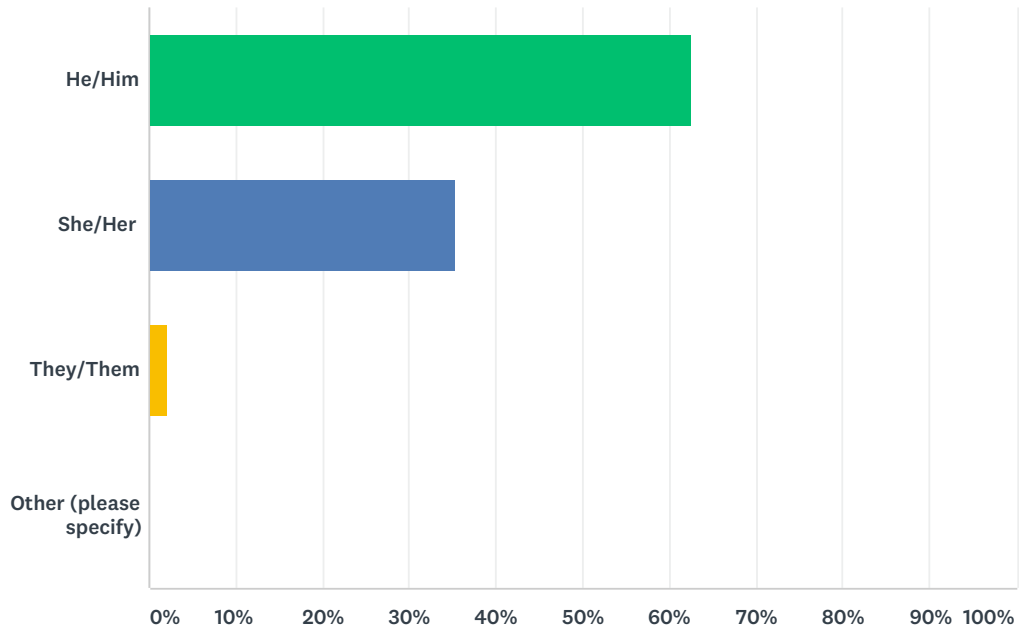

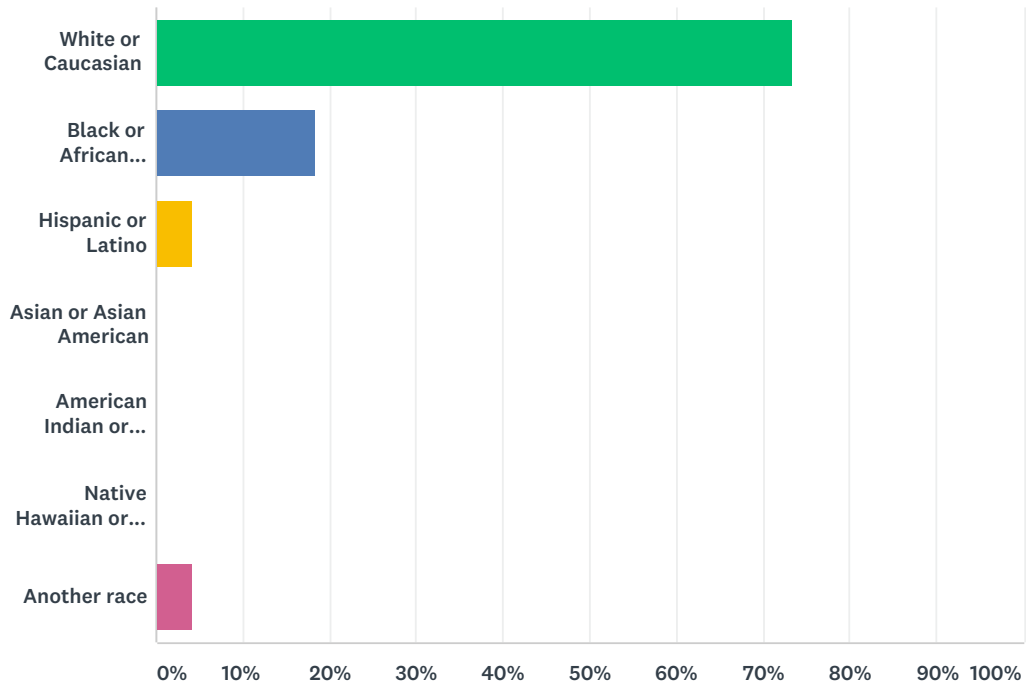

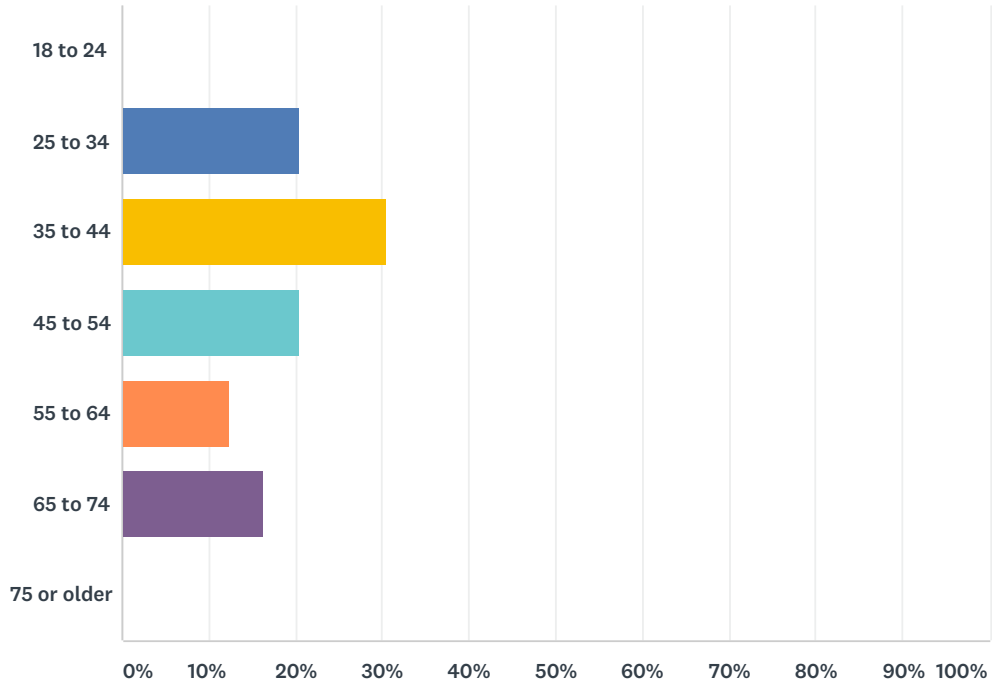

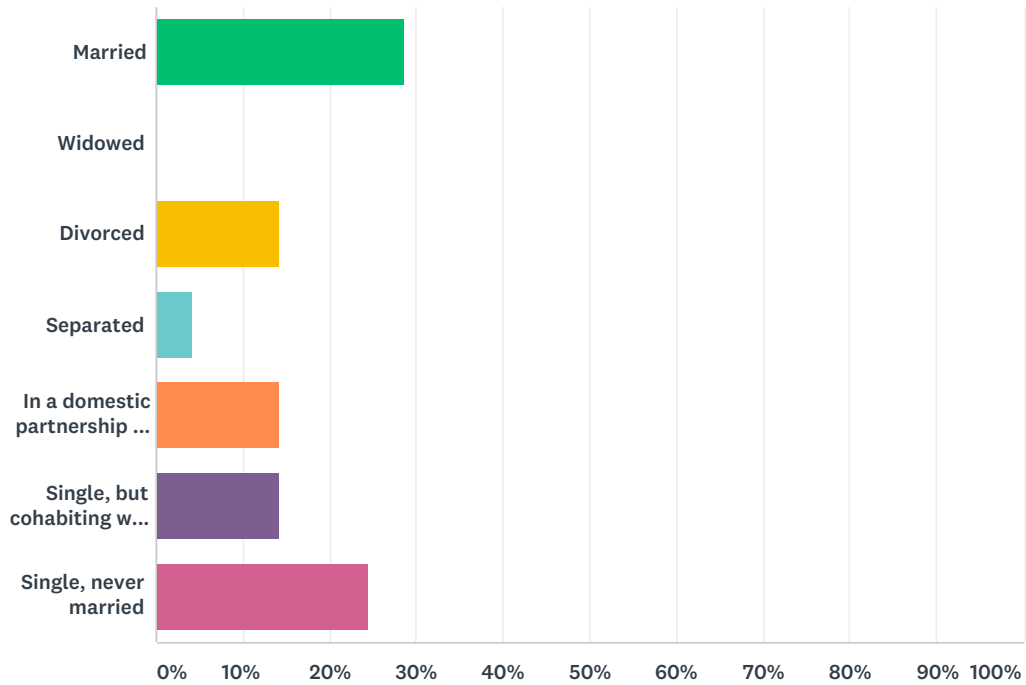

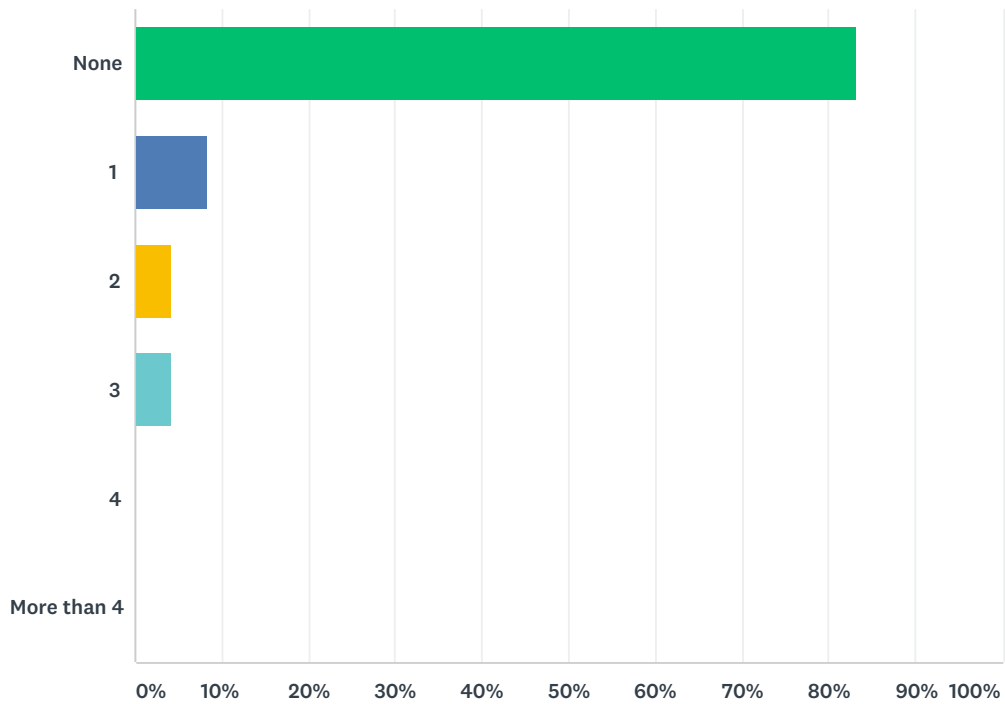

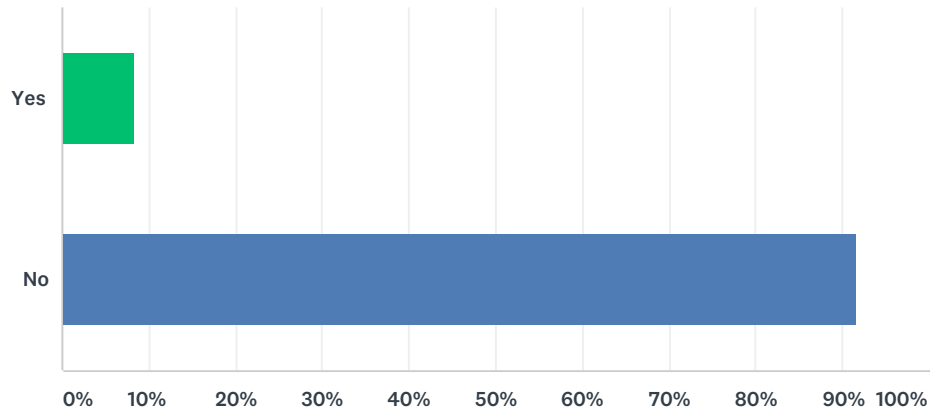

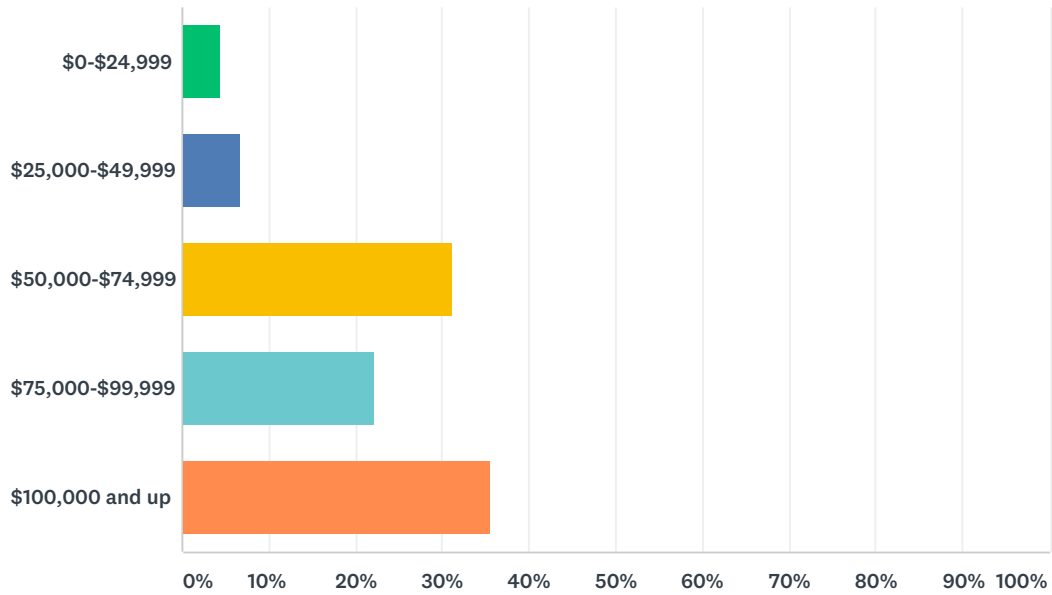
